Xeriscape is a style of landscape design that requires little or no irrigation and other maintenance. Xeriscaping can help you cut down on your monthly water bills, lowering outdoor water use by 30-50%, or more!

Environmental Benefits

- Water Resource Protection: By reducing water consumption, xeriscaping helps conserve precious water resources for the community and the environment.
- **Reduced Chemical Runoff**: Less watering means less need for fertilizers and pesticides, reducing the risk of chemical runoff into waterways.
- Habitat Creation: Xeriscape gardens can provide valuable habitat for native wildlife, supporting biodiversity.
